

Biography: Christopher A. Rozansky, C.M.

Chris Rozansky joined the City of Naples Airport Authority in March 2016 after serving as director of the Venice Municipal Airport for more than five years.

Chris was introduced to aviation through the Civil Air Patrol. He gained experience at airports in New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Ohio before graduating from The Ohio State University with a degree in aviation management. He spent seven years at Collin County Regional Airport in McKinney, Texas, before joining Venice Municipal Airport, where he led numerous strategic initiatives, managed 400 leases and completed more than \$25 million in airport improvements.

The Florida Department of Transportation named Chris 2012 Aviation Professional of the Year, and Airport Business magazine named him among the 2012 Top 40 Under 40 in the industry. He is a Certified Member of the American Association of Airport Executives and serves on the organization's General Aviation Committee. He also is a member of Florida Airports Council, serving as vice chair of its General Aviation Committee and past co-vice chair of the Noise and Community Affairs Committee.

As executive director of the Naples Airport Authority, Chris manages one of the busiest general aviation airports in the country. Naples Municipal Airport has an annual budget of more than \$20 million, employs 70 and generates an economic impact to the community of \$283.5 million annually.
