



Lenhard appointed to Naples Airport Authority board

NAPLES, Fla. (April 26, 2017) – The Naples City Council appointed Michael J. Lenhard to the board of commissioners of the City of Naples Airport Authority. The board is comprised of five citizen volunteers who are appointed to four-year terms to govern the Airport Authority.

Other commissioners are Ted Brousseau, Richard P. Evans, Donna Messer and James Rideoutte.

Lenhard retired from National Records Centers Inc. in Dallas, Texas, as president and CEO. He has more than two decades of experience in the records and information management industry. He currently serves as treasurer on the Aqualane Shores Association Inc. board of directors.

A private pilot and member of the Naples Pilots Association and the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association, Lenhard moved to Naples in 2015. Prior to moving his aircraft to Naples, he was based at Essex County Airport in Caldwell, New Jersey.

Naples Municipal Airport is home to flight schools, air charter operators, car rental agencies, and corporate aviation and nonaviation businesses, as well as fire/rescue services, mosquito control, the Collier County Sheriff's Aviation Unit and other community services. During the 2015-16 fiscal year, the airport accommodated 95,050 takeoffs and landings.

All funds used for the airport's operation, maintenance and improvements are generated from activities at the airport or federal and state grants from aviation-related user fees; the airport receives no property tax dollars. The Florida Department of Transportation values the airport's annual economic impact to the community at \$283.5 million.
