



Naples Airport Authority named 13th best FBO in U.S.

NAPLES, Fla. (May 17, 2017) – Professional Pilot magazine named Naples Airport Authority the 13th best fixed-base operator and the 5th best independent FBO in the United States in its annual Preferences Regarding Aviation Services and Equipment survey. Naples Airport Authority moved up 10 places this year from 23rd in the 2016 ranking for best U.S. FBO and seven places up from 12th best independent FBO.

“These rankings are a testament to our team’s hard work and dedication in providing excellent service to the airport’s customers,” said Chris Rozansky, executive director of Naples Airport Authority. “We are grateful to be recognized and are looking ways to further enhance the customer experience in the year ahead.”

Naples Airport Authority operates the FBO at Naples Municipal Airport, which provides fuel, hangar space, parking and other services to private and corporate aircraft and other general aviation operators.

The magazine’s 44th annual PRASE survey rankings are selected from ballots completed by qualified Professional Pilot readers and carefully vetted. The data was analyzed and tabulated independently by Conklin & de Decker, an industry-leading aviation consultancy.

Professional Pilot is a monthly business-aviation trade magazine founded in 1967. Readership includes professional pilots and other flight-crew members, maintenance technicians and ground support staff.

Naples Municipal Airport is home to flight schools, air charter operators, car rental agencies, and corporate aviation and nonaviation businesses, as well as fire/rescue services, mosquito control, the Collier County Sheriff’s Aviation Unit and other community services. During the 2015-16 fiscal year, the airport accommodated 95,050 takeoffs and landings.

All funds used for the airport’s operation, maintenance and improvements are generated from activities at the airport or federal and state grants from aviation-related user fees; the airport receives no property tax dollars. The Florida Department of Transportation values the airport’s annual economic impact to the community at \$283.5 million.
