The primary goal of the project is to create a 20-year airport development plan focusing on maintaining a safe, efficient, and environmentally-conscious airport facility for the community. To achieve this goal, it is essential that members of the public be involved in the process.

NAA is hosting two public informational open houses on April 30, 2019 and May 1, 2019 to present progress on the Master Plan and gain public comments.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) Services Building—A Request for Proposals (RFP) for construction of the ARFF Building was published on February 10, 2019. Due to the complexity of the project, the bid due date was extended to March 29, 2019. Based on the bid results, NAA staff has the intention of presenting a recommendation at the Regular Meeting of the Naples Airport Authority Board of Commissioners on April 18, 2019. Concurrent with publishing the RFP, the design plans were submitted to the City of Naples for permitting.

Hurricane Irma Recovery – The airport is in process of replacing hurricane-damaged hangar doors. As previously approved by the NAA Board, ten additional hangar doors will be replaced as part of our T-Hangar annual maintenance.

Airfield Painting— Select airfield markings will be repainted April 8 - 15, 2019. The work on Runway 5–23 will require an overnight closure. The remaining work will be completed during the day. Please monitor NOTAMs for any project updates.

IMPORTANT LEASING INFORMATION

The new, dedicated Leasing Office is fully operational and has enhanced service to our tenants. The office is located on the ground floor of the Airport Office Building located at 200 Aviation Drive North, Suite 8, adjacent to the General Aviation Terminal.

Are you subleasing hangar or office space? All subleases require NAA approval in order for you to maintain compliance with your lease. T-Hangar/T-Shelter subleases are limited to a maximum of 6-months during any one (1) year period. To request consent from the NAA for a sublease, or if you would like to get more information about the process, contact the Leasing Office.

Naples Airport is utilizing a new emergency alert notification system, Everbridge, in order to provide efficient communications to our airport community during times when the distribution of real-time information is vital.

As we head into the 2019 hurricane season, Everbridge will allow us to quickly disseminate important information to our tenants regarding any storm impacts to operations and/or airport closures using contact information that was provided on your airport badge application. ID Badge Renewals

All ID badges and ramp access stickers for Naples Airport will be expiring on October 31, 2019. Notifications will be posted around the airport with instructions for completing the renewal process. Reminders will also be sent via email to the addresses on file with the Airport Authority and renewal information will be available on our website at www.FlyNaples.com.

In order for a renewal to be processed, accounts must be in good standing and leases with the NAA must be in compliance. Some items that could affect the processing of a renewal include, but are not limited to:

- * An overdue account
- * Missing certificates of insurance
- * An unauthorized sublease
- * An unauthorized use of leasehold

To expedite your renewal, please take time now to ensure that there are no issues that will prevent or delay the process. 
Did you Know?

In 1942, Naples Airport was established as Naples Army Airfield by the United States Army Air Forces. Subsequently called the Naples Airdrome, it was turned over to the City of Naples and Collier County after World War II.

In 1951, the City of Naples purchased the airport and the former army barracks were converted into the first FBO.

The NAA was created in 1969 as an independent airport authority charged with the operation, development and improvement of the airport.

NAPLES YOUTH AVIATION PROJECT
