Job Description

This position is a perfect opportunity for experienced A&P Mechanics who are passionate about aviation and want to share their expertise in Aviation Maintenance Technology with eager students. The teaching assignment involves career and technical education in aviation maintenance, airframe, and power plant mechanics.

Minimum Qualifications

- A minimum of six years of recent full-time or the equivalent of part-time occupational experience in aircraft mechanics occupations
- Must have a current and valid FAA A&P certification and hold the Air Mech @7 7G. FAA FAR Part 147 standards required by the FAA which requires:
 - Knowledge of general principles with a high degree of practical application and hands-on skill levels according to FAA FAR Part 147 PREFERRED
- Provide instruction in aviation maintenance which is in accordance with the Operations Manual and Curriculum (OMC)
- Provide leadership in the development and revision of the OMC
- Participate in curriculum development, implementation, and evaluation
- Maintain current knowledge in the subject matter areas being taught
- Maintain appropriate standards of professional conduct and ethics
- Fulfill the professional responsibilities of a full-time faculty member including, but not limited to the following:
 - Teach scheduled blocks of instruction
 - Maintain accurate records of student enrollment, attendance, and progress
 - Submit student grades according to established deadlines
 - Post and maintain scheduled office hours
 - Participate in departmental meetings and college and/or district-wide activities and committees as assigned

Desirable Qualifications

- Demonstrated knowledge and use of the Canvas Learning Management System platform
- Good communication skills and the ability to instruct students in this field of study
- Qualified as a Designated Mechanic Examiner (DME) in order to test qualified applicants for the mechanic certification
- Educational and/or instructional preparation in aviation maintenance, airframe, and power plant systems

- Evidence of student success in teaching aviation maintenance, airframe and power plant systems
- Evidence of participation in student success initiatives in a post-secondary setting
- Evidence of an ability to address the instructional needs of a diverse student population
